Grades:

Your grade is weighted according to the following categories:

- Basic Assignments
 - o Every unit or cycle as we will call them, will have homework from the textbook. You are required to do the Main Ideas for the chapters assigned. This is due the day of the Supertest. You will be tested on this material so it is very important.
 - o Get in the habit of turning in your work on time. You may turn in late work, but each school day it is not turned in will lower the assignment a quarter of the grade. After three days don't bother!
 - o All make up work from an absence is expected to be made up at the earliest opportunity. Each student is expected to take the responsibility to communicate with Mr. Soderlund when this will happen. Students who fail to take care of this will risk receiving a Zero on those assignments.
- <u>Vocabulary Quizzes</u> –One every cycle or unit.
- Group Grades
 - o You will receive a grade for each cycle based on the placement of your group.
 - o This can change according to your grade on your Supertest. (We will go over this in depth.)
- SuperTest
 - o You will have a Supertest for each cycle.
- Economics video Project
 - o This will given in November and will be due the end of the semester.
